The EU Waste Framework Directive, as amended by Directive (EU) 2018/851 (WFD) provides for new information obligations for suppliers of products containing more than .01 percent of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC). The European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) has already set up a corresponding database (SCIP database) <https://echa.europa.eu/scip> to which the information on such products must be submitted. The information in the database may help waste operators in sorting and recycling products that may contain SVHC and support consumers in making informed choices and considering how to best use and dispose of such product.

The SCIP database has three main objectives:

1. Decrease the generation of waste containing hazardous substances by supporting the substitution of substances of concern in products sold.
2. Make information available to further improve waste treatment operations.
3. Allow authorities to monitor the use of substances of concern in products and initiate appropriate actions over the whole lifecycle of products, including at their waste stage.

Please be advised that we do not analyze for these substances.
